



**Caution!!! Please read the enclosed instruction before you begin assembling your furniture.'**

1. Check the furniture components in terms of quality. Any inconsistencies should be reported to the manufacturer.
2. Assemble the furniture on a flat, dry and clean surface.
3. To fix the individual elements, use the metal fittings provided in the set.
4. Drive the wood dowels in the prepared holes on the edge (make sure that the wood dowel part projecting from the hole does not exceed 10 mm – otherwise hit the dowel again with a hammer, shorten or replace it).

**General rules for the use and maintenance of furniture**

1. This piece of furniture is intended for use in dry premises, with humidity no greater than 65%.
2. The piece of furniture must not be exposed to the direct action of active heat sources, direct sunlight, or water.
3. Base cabinets must be placed on an even surface, and levelled. Assembled elements must be secured against falling over, for example by fixing pieces of furniture to the wall (due to various types of walls/surfaces, parts intended to fix a piece of furniture to the wall are not included the set of metal fixtures).
4. Wall cabinets must be placed on a mounting strip fixed to the wall (due to various types of walls/surfaces, furniture fixing elements are not included the set of metal fixtures), and then levelled and tightened to the wall.
5. Furniture elements should not be cleaned with the use of chemical agents (risk of surface damage). The piece of furniture can be cleaned with a slightly wet cloth (the cleaned surface should be dried with a clean and dry cloth). If cleaning agents are used, read about the intended use of a given agent, application methods and instructions provided by manufacturers.
